



Health Equity Communications Ambassador

Background

Love Your Menses, Inc. was founded in 2019 in response to the growing wellness need present in our communities, especially communities of color. The mission of Love Your Menses is to create a safe and uplifting space for adolescents and their parents to discuss and dispel myths about menstruation. We also hope to empower Black and Brown adolescents to love their menses and to develop a healthier body and mental image. Our vision is to destigmatize menstruation in communities of color using community dialogue, and evidence-based health education and education. Our business model includes a comprehensive approach to attaining our vision through a menstrual equity lens.

Overview

We are seeking a Health Equity Communications Ambassador to create effective, culturally competent health communications materials via email, social media, and print to adequately inform people of reproductive age about COVID-19 safety, vaccine resources, and how to take care of themselves. The goal of this project is to reduce COVID-19 infections, morbidity, and mortality among Black, Indigenous, and other people of color (BIPOC) of reproductive age in our hardest-hit cities and towns, as well as, to support education and awareness of vaccination efforts in Massachusetts.

Main Responsibilities:

The Health Equity Communications Ambassador will work 8 hours a week on the following:

- Draft COVID-19 & reproductive health social media posts and printed materials
- Create a monthly social media calendar with COVID-19 awareness related material
- Assist the project manager and coordinators with project-related operations
- Attend in-person and virtual community events and workshops in the Greater Boston area to promote project-related efforts

Compensation/ Benefits:

- This is a 6-month contract position (June 2022-December 2022) that is fully remote with occasional travel within the Greater Boston area.
- This is a non-benefited, stipended position. The fellow will receive a monthly stipend of \$800.
- The Health Equity Communications Ambassador will have an opportunity to attend professional development workshops, which will be approved and covered by Love Your Menses, Inc.

Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be currently in school or have received a degree in communications, public health, pre-medicine, social work, or another related field.
- Have a passion for public health
- Comfortable using technology (Canva, Google Workspace, Asana, etc.)
- Able to commit 6 months (June 2022- December 2022)
- This is a remote position but must have reliable transportation to attend in-person events
